Petition Under Section 439 Cr.P.C.

The petitioner begs this criminal original petition and state as follows:

1. The Judicial Magistrate, Kanchipuram on 11/11/04 has remanded the petitioner to judicial custody for alleged offences 120B, 34 r/w302 IPC.
2. The offence is in relation to the murder of the manger of perumal temple at Kanchipuram. The respondent has so far arrested all the accused and have remanded them to judicial custody. The petitioner has been roped in only on the confession given by the co accused.
3. The petitioner has been questioned many occasions and the petitioner has co operated with the respondent at all times.
4. The petitioner is the head of the kanchi mutt and highly reputed person in society. He is totally innocent of the charges levelled against him.

5. The petitioner is the head of a recognised scared Hindu Mutt having activities all over India and abroad. The mutt is caters to the multitude of people in the varying sails of education, hygiene and medical care.
6. The petitioner is willing to abide by any condition imposed by this Hon'ble Court.
7. The petitioner is willing to furnish sureties to the satisfaction of this Court.
