It is respectfully submitted that the above Accused/Petitioner had already been remanded to Judicial Custody by this Hon'ble Court on 12.11.2004 and the Petition filled on behalf of the Accused for certain relief is pending this Court and posted to-day for further proceedings.

The Respondent/Complainant are going on issuing Press Statements with further implication etc., in order to prejudice the defense and the Petition pending before this Hon'ble Court and the Bail Application pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Madras. The defense had no opportunity of even seeing the FIR or any other documents or seizures etc., allegedly submitted to this Court by the Police in the above case. The Respondent has stated in his counter in the High Court that he has submitted such statements/confessions/materials etc., to this Court.

In order to effectively defend the above Accused, and in exercising the right of an Accused for information, consultation, legal advise and fair opportunity and

trial, it is necessary that the relevant FIR and other records so far submitted to this Court which are said to be in the Court custody.

It is therefore prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to permit the council for the above Accused/Petitioner to peruse the relevant records in the custody of the Court in the presence of the Head Ministry and Officer of this Hon'ble Court and render justice.
